<u>Memory Verse</u>: ... "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." – Romans 10:13 NIV

Key Question: In your opinion, what do you understand that it takes for a person to go to heaven?

Answer: God's forgiveness that comes through our Faith

God's grace has saved you <u>because of your faith in Christ</u>. Your salvation doesn't come from anything you do. It is God's gift. – Ephesians 2:8 NIRV

- 1. Always remember that we are sharing good news.
 - "God loves you and wants you to be part of His family."
 - > John 3:16 & 2 Peter 3:9
- 2. Use the **Bible** to share the gospel.

3 Biblical Gospel Presentations:

The Roman Road: Romans 3:10 & 23, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9 & 13

The ABC's of Salvation: (See handout.)

One Verse Evangelism: John 1:12 or John 3:16

- 3. Ask the person if they <u>understand</u> what you have shared and if they would like to do this.
 - > Seek to clear up any confusion and to clear away any obstacles.

4. Lead in a model "sinners' prayer."

"Lord Jesus, I need you in my life. I believe that you died for my sins and that you rose from the dead. Please come into my heart, forgive my sins, and save me. The best that I know how, I am giving you control of my life. Please make a new person out of me. Jesus, I love you. Thank you for loving me and for saving me. Amen."

5. Take time to offer guidance as to what <u>comes next</u>.
