Pastor Mark's Remarks

As we begin working this principle, we are reminded that our progress in life change is dependent on our willingness to surrender our lives to Christ. The saying, "But for the Grace of God," is a great reminder of the context of the principle. This miracle of life change is not a result of good works or better living. It is not a matter we can boast of. It is a gift from God. We are reminded of how well our lives have worked out for us in the past without Christ guidance. We must decide and yield. In our recovery, we arrive at a place where we are forced to choose - Do I continue to attempt to follow the false gods of human perfection, coping and gratification, or do I fully embrace the merciful grace of God through submission of self will?

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from your-selves, it is the gift of God - Ephesians 2:8

Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-centered recovery ministry for anyone struggling with hurt, pain or addiction of any kind. It is a safe place to find community, encouragement and freedom from the issues that are controlling your life or the life of someone you love.
