Pastor Mark's Remarks

Hi Friends,

The month of May as been a good one at Freedom. In case you missed worship the past couple of weeks, let me point out a couple of important things that we celebrated together. On Mother's Day, eight families dedicated a total of nine babies and children during worship!

On the following Sunday, we recognized two graduates from within our church family. Nick Wilson graduated from Robertsdale High School and will be attending Coastal Community College this fall on a full scholarship. And Charlie Lemon will graduate this summer with a bachelor's degree from Liberty University. Please join me in congratulating them for these important milestone achievements.

As summer kicks off, we will be sending a team of 15 people from Freedom on mission to Tizimin, Mexico (on the Yucatan Peninsula) to minister to the Mayan people there. This team will depart Pensacola on Wednesday morning, May 30^{th} , and return on Wednesday evening, June 6^{th} . Please remember this team in prayer.

One of the things that you helped us to realize in the month of May is the incredible potential for reaching and ministering to people via the internet using social media. For years we have relied on our website as our primary online presence. And our media

In fact, if you haven't visited the website lately, you owe it to yourself to visit it this week and check out all that Dave has done, particularly with the Sermons tab. But Dave, along with my wife Jacque who manages the church's Facebook, have demonstrated this month how many more people we can touch on a weekly basis through our online presence than we do through our attendance at the church campus. As a prime example, we had around 120 people present for worship on Mother's Day. But over the course of the next eight days, we had over 1,200 people who viewed that service through our Facebook posting!

I hope this serves as both an encouragement and a reminder that though we are young and small as a church right now, God is already using us to touch many lives. And He has plans for us to reach and touch MANY more! One simple way that you can help us to do this if you have a Facebook account is by consistently sharing the worship service each week when it appears in your feed.
