Pastor Mark's Remarks

The weather feels like there is no end to summer in sight, but the summer break for school and for small groups is nearly over. That means that good things are on the horizon as we gear up for the new church year.

Our adult small group ministry will kick off the new church year on August 19th. What an exciting time to be part of our church and the Freedom Missions Ministry! I have a couple of things to which I'd like to draw your attention.

First, we will be welcoming Bill and Kathy Craver to our church on Sunday morning, September 23rd. They're excited to meet you all and to speak to you about the mission in Tizimin. In case you don't know, Bill and Kathy are the missionaries to the Mayan people in the Yucatan and the directors of DCI. Fifteen of us had the extreme pleasure to serve with this past May. It truly is a life-changing mission for our teams and for the Mayans we serve. Please mark your calendars to come hear Bill and Kathy talk about how the Spirit is moving among the Mayan people in the Yucatan. Bill and Kathy are wonderful people with a true heart to share the love of Christ to the Mayans. We are blessed to be part of that ministry.

Right after our service on the 23rd, we'll be having an informational meeting about our next trip to Tizimin. If you know you want to come on the next trip, if you think you MIGHT want to come, or if you just would like to hear about it, please make plans to attend. For those of you who know they want to attend, it's a good time to go ahead and give your \$100 per person deposit to ensure your spot on next year's trip. The dates for that trip are set for May 31st - June 7th, 2019.

Secondly, on August 25th, I'll be traveling to Guatemala to serve and discover with a mission organization called "Guatemala Landing Zone" (you can find their site on Facebook - check 'em out!). I covet your prayers as I travel and while I'm there. Rabinal is the small town where the Mayans were relocated in 1982 after the Guatemalan government's genocide of the Mayan people living in Rio Negro. I'll be serving the survivors and relatives of that tragedy. Many of you may know Mary Purvis, with whom I will be serving. Mary is the director of GMZ, and her father, Bill Haring, is a member of Freedom Church.

Keep and ear and eye open as I'm trying to work with some area groups to serve local populations in our area. I'm also looking for a good point of contact to connect with the unchurched Latino population in Baldwin County. Thank you for all the prayers, love and support you've shown as we get this ministry off the ground.
