Pastor Mark's Remarks

Hi Friends,

I hope that you had a great Thanksgiving and that your heart is ready for the Advent/Christmas season ahead. This will be a fun month at Freedom with lots of opportunities to enjoy your church family amid the sights, songs and message of this important season.

As 2018 moves toward its close, I have been seeking God's direction for the coming year for Freedom Church. And one of the things that I have felt strongly impressed on me is that God is calling us as a church to spend 2019 getting to know Him better together through His Word. And to that end, I encourage you to join me for a spiritual journey in the coming year. I want us all to read through the New Testament and Psalms together in 2019. And to help facilitate that, I am doing two things.

First, I will be supplying a devotional Bible reading plan for each week of the year. The plan will be very simple. It will involve a reading each day which will take only about five minutes. On the five weekdays of every week, we will cover a chapter a day from the New Testament. And on weekends, we will turn to the Psalms, which is the worship and prayer guide of the Old Testament.

As a second piece of this plan, I am changing up the small group lesson plans for 2019. Rather than basing the lessons on the sermon each week, we will have a lesson every week that will be taken from your devotional Scripture reading for the week. My hope is that this twopronged approach will help to stir a new hunger within us for the Word. And I truly believe that as we read and study the Word together in this way, that we will grow closer to one another and closer to God.

I will be putting the reading plan in front of you in many ways throughout the year. You will see it each month in the newsletter and each week on the website, on the church's Facebook page, and at the bottom of your sermon outlines. I hope that you will join me in this journey ahead. But I don't want you to wait another month to get into the Word. Why not let the Advent season be a time to turn your attention to Christ each day by spending a few minutes getting to know Jesus better through His Word? I encourage you to read through the gospel of either Luke or John between now and Christmas. And each day as you read a chapter, pause to ask Jesus to help you get to really know Him and His heart in a fresh way this month.

I look forward to sharing with you in the good things that God has in store for us this month and in the year ahead!
