## YOU GET WHAT YOU DESERVE Things Jesus Never Said – Part 4 Luke 23:32-43 February 2, 2020

Two others—criminals—were also led away with [Jesus]. When they arrived at the place called The Skull, they crucified Him there, along with the criminals, one on the right and one on the left. – Luke 23:32-33 HCSB

Then <u>one of the criminals</u> hanging there <u>began to yell insults at Him</u>: "Aren't you the Messiah? <u>Save yourself and us</u>!" But the other answered, rebuking him: "Don't you even fear God, since you are undergoing the same punishment? <u>We are punished justly</u>, because <u>we</u> <u>are getting back what we deserve</u> for the things we did...." – Luke 23:39-41a HCSB

"You and I are guilty. <u>We deserve to die because we did wrong</u>. <u>But this man has done</u> <u>nothing wrong</u>." Then he said, "<u>Jesus, remember me when you begin ruling as king</u>!" Then Jesus said to him, "I promise you, <u>today you will be with me in paradise</u>." – Luke 23:41-43 ERV

> Faith in Jesus leads to our forgiveness and makes us part of <u>God's family</u>.

But to all who <u>believed</u> in him and <u>accepted</u> him, he gave the right to become <u>the children of</u> <u>God</u>. – John 1:12 NLT

**God's mercy keeps us from receiving** *any* of the <u>punishment we deserve</u>.

In the past all of us lived like that, trying to please our sinful selves. We did all the things our bodies and minds wanted. Like everyone else in the world, <u>we deserved to suffer God's anger</u> just because of the way we were. <u>But God is rich in mercy</u>, and he loved us very much. We were spiritually dead because of all we had done against him. But he gave us new life together with Christ. – Ephesians 2:3-5 ERV

## **God's grace ensures that we get** *all* that we <u>need but don't deserve</u>.

I mean that <u>you have been saved by grace</u> because you believed. You did not save yourselves; <u>it was a gift from God</u>. You are not saved by the things you have done, so there is nothing to boast about. <u>God has made us what we are</u>. – Ephesians 2:8-10a ERV

Jesus has the power of God. And <u>his power has given us everything we need</u> to live a life devoted to God. <u>We have these things because we know him</u>. – 2 Peter 1:3 ERV

God's love ensures that our failures are <u>forgotten</u> and never <u>used against</u> <u>us</u>. We sinned against him, but <u>he didn't give us the punishment we deserved</u>. <u>His love for his</u> <u>followers is as high above us as heaven is above the earth</u>. And he has taken our sins as far away from us as the east is from the west. – Psalm 103:10-12 ERV

*"I am the one who wipes away <u>ALL</u> your sins. <u>I do this to please myself</u>. <u>I will not remember</u> <u>your sins</u>." – Isaiah 43:25 ERV* 

*"…I will forgive their wickedness, and <u>I will never again remember their sins</u>." – Jeremiah 31:34 NLT*
