Outrageous Openness Means That...

1. We boldly share what God says and what we are expecting from Him.

When we brought the Good News to you, we came with more than words. We brought that Good News with power, with the Holy Spirit, and with the sure knowledge that it was true. Also you know how we lived when we were with you. We lived that way to help you. – 1 Thess. 1:5 ERV

My friends all laugh at me when I call on God and expect him to answer me. - Job 12:4 NCV

2. We share our homes, meals, resources and time with others.

Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well. – 1 Thess. 2:8 NIV

<u>You became imitators of us and of the Lord</u>, for you welcomed the message in the midst of severe suffering with the joy given by the Holy Spirit. -1 Thess. 1:6 NIV

Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ. – 1 Cor. 11:1 NIV

3. We are open about our <u>pain</u>, struggles, and <u>failures</u> as well as our victories.

And so you became a <u>model</u> to all the believers in Macedonia and Achaia. – 1 Thess. 1:7 NIV
